Organized combined services with people of other faiths

- Coming together to pray (each in their own way) with others for peace, etc.
- Local occasions for interreligious prayer
- Bishop Andrew Wingate, Leicester's Advisor in Interreligious Relations and Director of the St Philip's Centre for Theology and Ministry in a Multi-Faith Society, lists a number of prayers and scripture references that would be suitable for Inter-Religious Services.¹

Seminars/discussions/talks

- Doctrinal issues, e.g., Ideas of God, sin, virtue.
- Moral issues, euthanasia, pollution.
- Topics common to the Abrahamic religions
- Prayer, meditation

Group activities

- Celebration of Eid with Muslims or Festival of Light with Hindus
